CARB and Formaldehyde Standards Act Compliance

Please be advised that Kährs is compliant with CARB Phase 1, 2 and the FSA (Formaldehyde Standards Act)

To comply with the requirements of the California Air Resources Board (“CARB”) rulemaking for Formaldehyde emissions, Kährs is required to meet the standards as set forth in the regulation order 93120-93120.12, Title 17, CCR Airborne Toxic Control Measure for Formaldehyde Emission from Composite Wood Products. <http://www.arb.ca.gov/toxics/compwood/implementation/faq.htm>

The national standard, Formaldehyde Standards for Composite Wood Products Act (FSA), 1 July 2013, has also adopted the emissions standards for composite wood from the CARB regulations. <http://www.govtrack.us/congress/bills/111/s1660/text>
